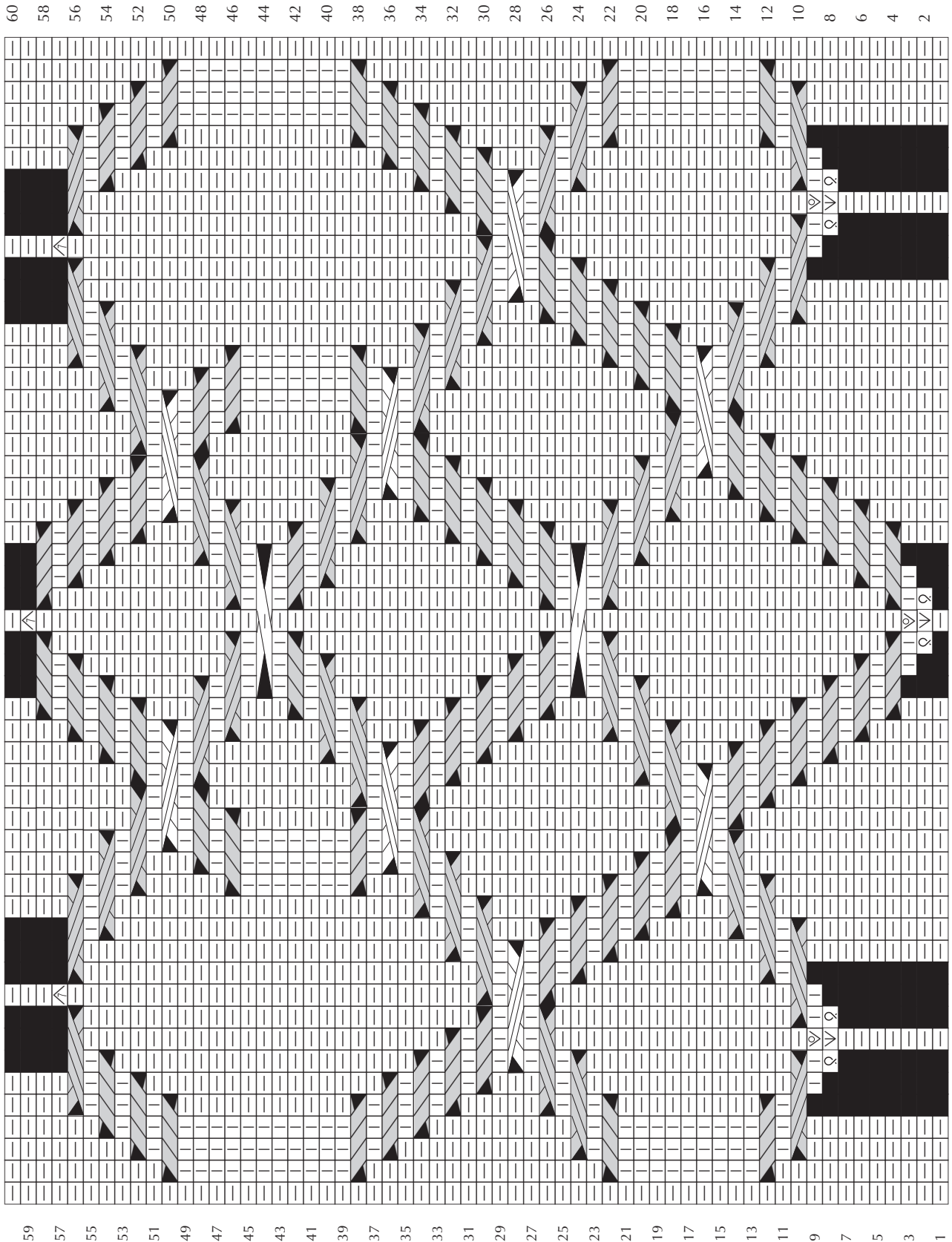


















# Celtic Love Knot Chart

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## Abbreviations and key to chart

-  Knit on RS, purl on WS
-  Purl on RS, knit on WS
-  No stitch—placeholder symbol in chart
-  Center YO increase: [P1, yo, p1] into same stitch
-  Center double increase: Work [k1tbl, k1] into next st, then insert tip of LH ndl behind the vertical strand running between the two sts just made, lift it up onto LH ndl and knit into it
-  Make 1 Right (M1R): Insert the LH needle from back to front under the strand of yarn between the ndls and knit into the front of it
-  Make 1 Left (M1L): Insert the LH needle from front to back under the strand of yarn between the ndls and knit into the back of it.
-  7-stitch closing decrease: Slip next 4 sts to RH needle, pass the 2nd st on RH needle over the 1st st; slip the center st back to the LH needle, pass the 2nd st on LH needle over the 1st st; slip the center st back to the RH needle, pass the 2nd st on RH needle over the 1st st; slip the center st back to the LH needle, pass the 2nd st on LH needle over the 1st st; slip the center st back to the RH needle, pass the 2nd st on RH needle over the 1st st; slip the center st back to the LH needle, pass the 2nd st on LH needle over the 1st st and k center st
-  3/1 RPC (3/1 Right Purl Cross): Slip next st to cable needle and hold at back of work, k3, then p1 from cable needle
-  3/1 LPC (3/1 Left Purl Cross): Slip next 3 sts to cable needle and hold at front of work, p1, then k3 from cable needle
-  3/2 RPC (3/2 Right Purl Cross): Slip next 2 sts to cable needle and hold at back of work, k3, then p2 from cable needle
-  3/2 LPC (3/2 Left Purl Cross): Slip next 3 sts to cable needle and hold at front of work, p2, then k3 from cable needle
-  3/3 RC (3/3 Right Cross): Slip next 3 sts to cable needle and hold at back of work, k3, then k3 from cable needle
-  3/3 LC (3/3 Left Cross): Slip next 3 sts to cable needle and hold at front of work, k3, then k3 from cable needle
-  3/1/3 RPC (3/1/3 Right Purl Cross): Slip next 4 sts to cable needle and hold at back of work, k3, slip left-most st from cable needle back to LH needle and purl it, then k3 from cable needle
-  3/1/3 LPC (3/1/3 Left Purl Cross): Slip next 4 sts to cable needle and hold at front of work, k3, slip left-most st from cable needle back to LH needle and purl it, then k3 from cable needle
